

### Obedience Club of Daytona

#### Meeting Minutes

May 9, 2022

President Michele Lemole welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. The sign in sheet was passed around - 18 members were present and there was 1 guest.

Report of the Secretary: We had no applications for membership. There was no correspondence.

Minutes of the last meeting were not read because they were published in the Chatterbarks.

Report of the Treasurer:

Nina introduced Officer Rossi, an Ormond Beach Police Officer, who will be talking to us about all things interesting. Officer Rossi is a dog lover and has two children. He's been very fortunate in his career to do the things he's done which have included detective, hostage negotiator, and firearms instructor. He goes into the community and talks to people about little things that would help their families lead safer lives. Andrew Rossi has been a police officer for 24 years. He is assigned to the Community Outreach Division where he speaks to smaller, intimate groups which is very rewarding and shows the community that the police really do care. In our canine program we're smaller than Daytona Beach. We have two dogs to our patrol shift, Klaus who is a 1 yr. old GSD, the previous dog we lost to cancer whose name was Kane and our Black Lab Rex whose main job is to find product. If it's on a person, in a vehicle, or if someone is running away and throws drugs or a gun he would be the dog to find it. Dog's have such good scent they find drugs in the craziest of places. The Sheriff's office has about has about 25 to 30 dogs and they do a little bit if everything. We are glad to have our canine partners and we take good care of them when they are working and retired. The dogs are flown in from Germany and are pre-trained. Officer Rossi started the safety program by saying Summer always breeds a certain wave of burglaries at homes and in vehicles. Don't keep your garage door opener on your visor. Always lock your car and lock your car registration and insurance cards in the glove department. Don't leave bags, computers, firearms, or purses in the car. Catalytic convertors are now being stolen from the outside of vehicles. You should lock your car in the garage and if you out park by lighted area. Don't confront burglars. The question was asked about what to do if you have a burglar? Officer Rossi said there are laws that say you can protect yourself on your own property called the Castle Doctrine it does cover you however, it does not mean your car. If you have a gun and you're going to confront somebody and you end up pulling the trigger you better be able to justify that it was the last resort you had. If someone is breaking into your car call the police department immediately and let them handle it. More people are killed with their own guns than the bad guys guns. I know that's not what you want to hear. Write down your tag number, vin number, insurance number and registration and keep in a safe place to give police. Fraud scams: Do not give out any information. Any calls from the government asking for money are fraud calls. Ask for their number and name and then call the IRA and ask if that person is an employee. If anything seems to good to be true call the police and tell them about it and they will advise you before you get involved and fall for the scam. Officer Rossi left lots of booklets for handouts and thanked us for inviting him. He said if we had further questions to call him anytime. We really enjoyed having him come and speak at our meeting and gave him a big round of applause.

Ralph had lots of good items donated lately like crates and travel crates which has raised his memorial fund to over \$5K. He is also helping Pat Dean get Stewards for the July trial.

Michele Lemole said we need to replace our outdoor building sign and Ralph has been doing the legwork finding out prices. The board has decided to get the same kind we currently have which is between \$250 and \$300 so with that we need to bring that to the membership for approval. That price is soup to nuts including installation. It will be the same sign with UV protection on it. We had looked into a bigger sign but that sign didn't work with what we wanted so we have decided to go with the same sign we have. There was a motion to vote to purchase the sign and the vote was carried to purchase the sign. Michele said you might have seen in the newsletter Pat said we need to get commercial gutters installed on the backside of the building because we have an issue with water. There is water coming off the back which comes into the building and we have tried numerous fixes and nothing has completely worked. If we put the gutters up it would shuttle the water away from the problem areas and control where it was coming down. We did get an estimate for that which is \$4,500 which is the total cost of commercial gutters and the box on the top would also be commercial grade. We will have a vote on this repair at the meeting next month and if you have any questions please call Pat Mozden because she has been doing all the leg work on this project. Michele would like to suggest that we have some refreshments at meetings hopefully to attract more people to come as well as doing some programs which people would be interested in seeing. If you have any ideas please let Nina or me know. We are going to try to get some people talk about some of the other dog sports. Lynd Weaver will be asked to talk about scent work. Maybe Carole Schultz could come over and talk about Barnhunt. We could have a volunteer to take care of the refreshments. We voted on a reimbursement of \$20 to the volunteer. Michele will bring refreshments next month.

Anna reminded us that July 9<sup>th</sup> we will be having a Match the Saturday before the trial. Anna needs people to help before the trial. We will not be having pre-registration before the trial like last year. We will do day of the Match registration. The Match is always well attended and it's a good moneymaker for the club.

Helpers will get a free run. 😌 We'll see you there!

Michele motioned to adjourn. It was seconded by Karl Shalansky.

Then on Saturday again back-to-back trials with judges Linda Unger judging Novice and Luci and Ron Seeley judging Open and Utility for a total of 3 trial each over the weekend.

It is usually a challenge to get a full staff of stewards to step up and volunteer but this time even at this early date the events are almost fully staffed. Just tonight I had a new club member volunteer to steward not really knowing the job at hand.

She is presently enrolled with her dog in an intermediate class. I assured her not to worry and that with minimal training she would be fine with stewarding in the Novice Class. I think the experience will give her a good look at trialing and build the confidence to try it before too long with her dog. Of course, taking Novice training would be her next step toward that goal.

We will have a Match the Saturday, July 9 before our Trials it is a run through to practice what you could expect in the actual trial but with a make-believe judge (usually an experience club member) playing the role of the judge. Please contact Anna Johnson if you can help !

As you most likely have noticed the floors are boxed off in 6ft X 6ft squares for social distance spacing and the plan is to leave them in place even though the CDC guidelines have been relaxed. These boxes will keep the crating much more organized and make it much easier for exhibitors to find a crate spot without feeling like they are intruding on someone else's space.
