




Wins & Brags



OBEDIENCE CLUB OF DAYTONA**GENERAL MEETING****MAY 8, 2023**

President Michele Lemole called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and welcomed everyone to the club meeting. The sign in sheet had been passed around and 15 members were present.

Minutes of the last meeting were not read because they were published in the Chatterbarks newsletter.

Report of the Secretary: There were no new applications for membership and there was no correspondence.

Report of the Treasurer: Renee said she had moved some of our savings in the bank to pay down our club mortgage.

Pat Mozden said some lightbulbs in the training center were bad and they could be thrown away. Ralph was concerned that one of the upstairs bathrooms had an out of order sign and no one had written it on his board in the hallway for repairs. Pat said to make sure we turn the water on periodically in the upstairs bathroom toilets so that the parts won't get brittle and brake. Ralph said he always has the water turned on for upstairs bathrooms for trials. The exception for this would be the Scent trial because they would have the access to that area blocked off.

Ralph looked up on the AKC site and it said our premium for our trials would be on our OCOD website. Ralph found out that the premium for the trial was listed on our website at the bottom of all the classes instead of being at the beginning of the website listed as an event. This change would probably bring us more signups for the trial. Ralph sent a copy to the AKC so they could list it on "Infodog". Ralph will see if the premium is listed on our Facebook page and have Maria add it if it's not there.

Military and First Responders can take our Basic classes and be reimbursed for the cost. They pay \$125 to OCOD upfront and when they complete the class Ralph pays back \$80 from his military fund to OCOD. Renee then issues a check of the amount the veteran paid to Ralph so can reimburse the veteran. Ralph says he needs an understudy to learn what he does for the trials. He also is a worker for the clubs that are there at the training center. He is willing to train someone. Pat Dean will send out a request to the membership. Ralph wants to know if we would like to have a second trial on Sunday because it would bring in more money. We have done that in the past for the other days.

Wins and Brags were announced. Any new Wins and Brags should be submitted to Joan for the Chatterbarks.

Michele is going to give us a general idea about Dock Diving which is a really cool team sport. You will throw an obstacle of your choice as long as it is not alive or food into a pool and your dog has to jump in and retrieve it. The items can be bumpers, toys, balls etc.. They measure how far your dog jumps into the pool. The dog is measured from the rear of the dog where the tail is connected to the body. It's in the water so your dog gets to stay cool. There are places that have pools and also give lessons. Some of the places are: Head Start Canine in Green Cove Springs, Ocala Dog Ranch who does lessons and competitions, International Dog Sports, who is rather new and more cost effective, Ultimate Diving Dogs, and North American Diving Dogs. She belongs to a group called North American Diving Dogs. Distance jump is when you send your dog to retrieve an obstacle. They run out to the end of the dock and jump off. There is a class for smaller dogs that are 12inches and smaller.


Then there is a class for dogs that are 16 inches and larger. When your dogs are 8 yrs. old they can jump in the veterans division. When they jump into the pool they have to swim out and retrieve whatever you have thrown into the pool...bright colors are the best. Blue and yellow are the best colors for the dogs to see. They have to bring it back to you and it is timed. You get 4 minutes of dock time. North American Dock Diving Dogs entry fee is \$25 per splash. You need 5 splashes to get a title in a certain jump height or distance. The dock is two feet above the water. Some of athletic dogs like Whippets are jumping over 30 feet. Most of the pools are 45 feet now. You don't want to throw much farther than your dog jumps because swimming far out to get the bumper is tiring. You should wait till your dog is 1 year or older. You should have some sort of lessons before you attempt Dock Diving or Fastcat. It's a lot of fun especially in the warmer weather.

Michele said if there is nothing else I call for a motion to adjourn. Shirley seconded the motion. Michele thanked everyone for coming.
