Also, the club will be holding a Scent Work Seminar on August 27th. So get signed up if you haven't.

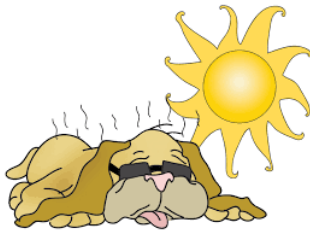

All dogs are eligible to earn AKC Therapy Dog titles,

including purebreds and mixed breeds. To earn an AKC Therapy Dog title, dogs must be registered or listed with AKC and have a number. This includes any one of

these three options:

1. AKC Registration Number (purebreds with registered parents)
2. This is often known as the "AKC papers" provided to a dog owner by a breeder. If you have received a registration paper from your breeder or previous owner you can [register online](#).
3. PAL Number (purebreds not registerable)
4. [PAL is Purebred Alternative Listing](#). PAL (formerly called ILP) is a program that allows unregistered dogs of [registerable breeds](#) to compete in AKC Performance and Companion Events. PAL dogs include the many wonderful purebred dogs who may have come from shelters or rescue without AKC registration.
5. Canine Partners Number (for mixed breeds or non registerable)
6. Used by mixed breed dogs (and dogs otherwise not registered with AKC such as some purebreds from other countries). A special [Canine Partners Therapy Dog Enrollment Form](#) is available for mixed breed Therapy Dogs needing to obtain a dog number in order to receive their Therapy Dog Title. This form must be submitted together with the [Therapy Dog Title Application](#).

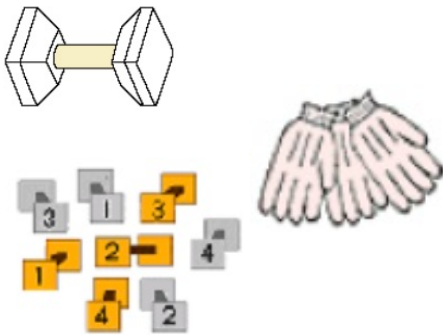

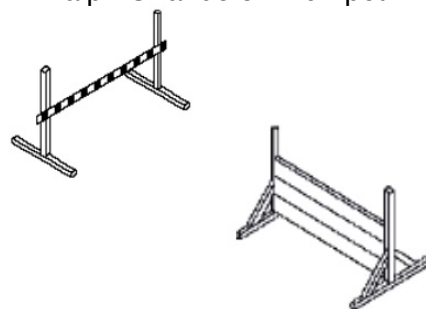

HALIFAX HUMANE SOCIETY SUMMER CAMP

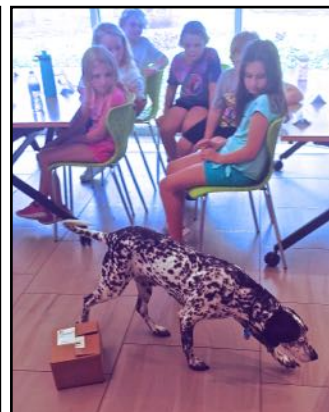
Each week this summer, Frank Horvath with Zibber & Ksusha, has been presenting at the Halifax Humane Society (HHS) Summer Camp. The main theme of the presentation is that dog sports are an excellent way to have fun with your dog while building better communication and a stronger bond with them. The sports of agility, rally and scent work are introduced and brief demonstrations are given.

Since Zibber was adopted from HHS when he was 3 years old, and Ksusha was re-homed when she was 4, a secondary theme is that adult dogs in shelters, and adult dogs that need a new home, can be trained to perform quite well in dog sports.

After the presentation, stickers of the dogs are given to the children and there is petting time.

Ralph Orlando with Smokey coordinated 9 visits with one each week for the 9 weeks of summer camp with kids ages 6- 13. I brought scent articles and told the kids that I taught Smokey how find the right number in the pile. I scented the article and then told Smokey to find #3 Metal or #2 leather. They were impressed but then I explained that my scent on the one was how he found it. One little girl figured it out before I spilled the beans.

GENERAL MEETING

JULY 11, 2022

President Michele Lemole welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

The sign in sheet was passed around - 18 members were present and there were no guests.

Report of the Secretary: We have no new applications for membership. There was no correspondence.

Minutes of the last meeting were not read because they were published in the Chatterbarks.

Report of the Treasurer: There was a brief discussion about the profit and loss report of our account. Renee said she will retire from her job as Treasurer at the end of this year. She will be available to help train her successor.

Ralph talked about our trial on July 15th, 16th, and 17th. You will be able to set up your crates from three-five pm on Thursday the 14. If anyone is not in the trial please remove your crates. Friday will be double rally and Saturday will be double Obedience. Sunday will be a single Obedience and will probably end by 2 pm. Ralph needs a few more volunteers. Please give him a call if you can help 😊. Ralph also mentioned the K9 Memorial he has been raising money to help with the expenses of purchasing a Bronze GSD statue. They have already cleared the land but the project has stalled and they are assigning someone else to complete it. Ralph will stay on top of the upcoming changes. Ralph also has multiple sources for charitable donations to his military dog group like his vet group, our dog club members who bring him items to sell, and his golf group.

Nina received our new printer and is helping with printing applications for membership, class signup sheets, and graduation forms.

AKC Judge Lind Weaver spoke about service and working dogs and the study University of Washington had done on 10,000 dogs. Texas had also done a study on 20,000 working dogs. She pointed how and why canines sniff and how important it is for them to learn scent work. She said let your dog sniff it's a great reliever of stress. Lind talked about exercising your dog and nutrition. She spoke about dry kibble dog food and how the quality is not always what it should be. She had heard about some dogs that had gotten sick and died because the dogfood they ingested was contaminated with phenobarbital. She cooks for her dogs and gives them a diet of ground beef, hardboiled egg, Honest Kitchen, and Pumpkin.

Michele asked if anyone else wanted to speak. Shirley Shalansky motioned to adjourn/2nd Renee

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
