Dear members:

I imagine our members already know this but just in case: did you realize that in the eyes of the law, your loving dog is a piece of property? Yes, like a lamp or a sofa – they are property.

The recent passing of friends reminded me of the importance of having your estate ready for the day when you are no longer here. And if all you own is your dog – they are your estate.

This is a topic none of us like to discuss. When I volunteered at HHS, I saw many elderly dogs arrive - typically due to the death of their owner. The shelter did their best to find good homes for them, but wouldn't you prefer to know that your dog will be loved by someone responsible who will care for them the way you did?

If you haven't already taken steps to make a will that will provide for your dog's care in the event of your passing, please do so immediately. It does not have to be expensive, there are on-line documents and paralegals who can do simple wills inexpensively although consulting with an attorney is best for many people.

You promised you would take care of them for as long as they lived. Make sure you follow that promise all the way through.

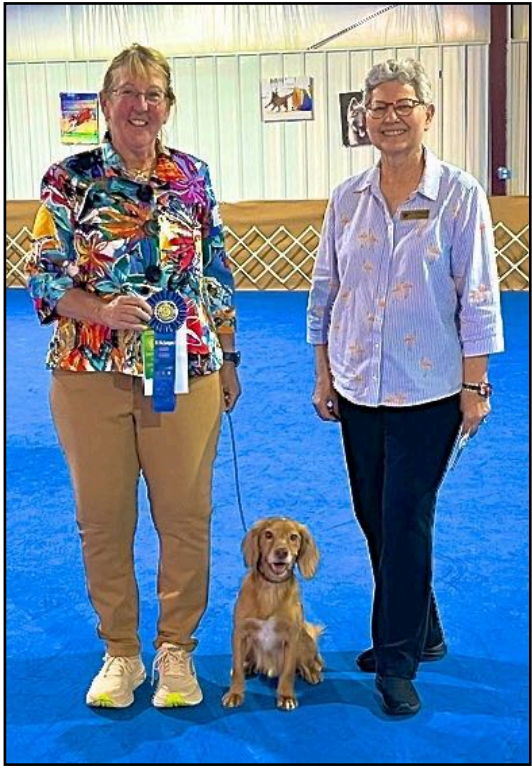

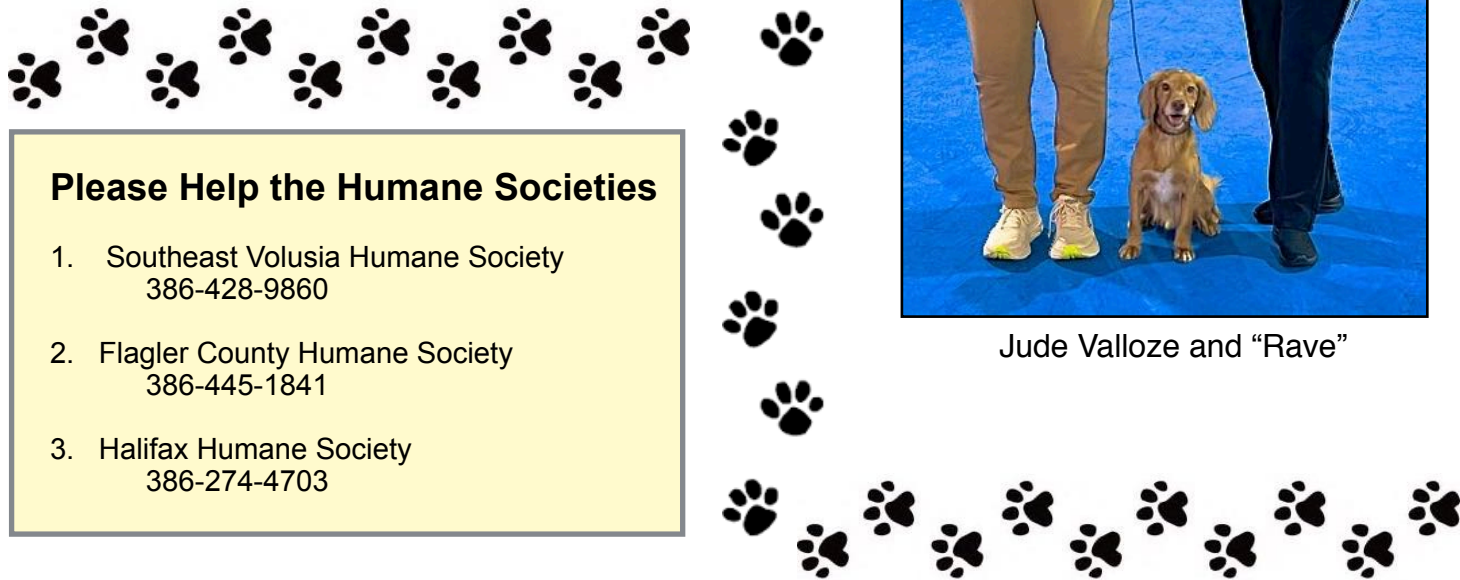

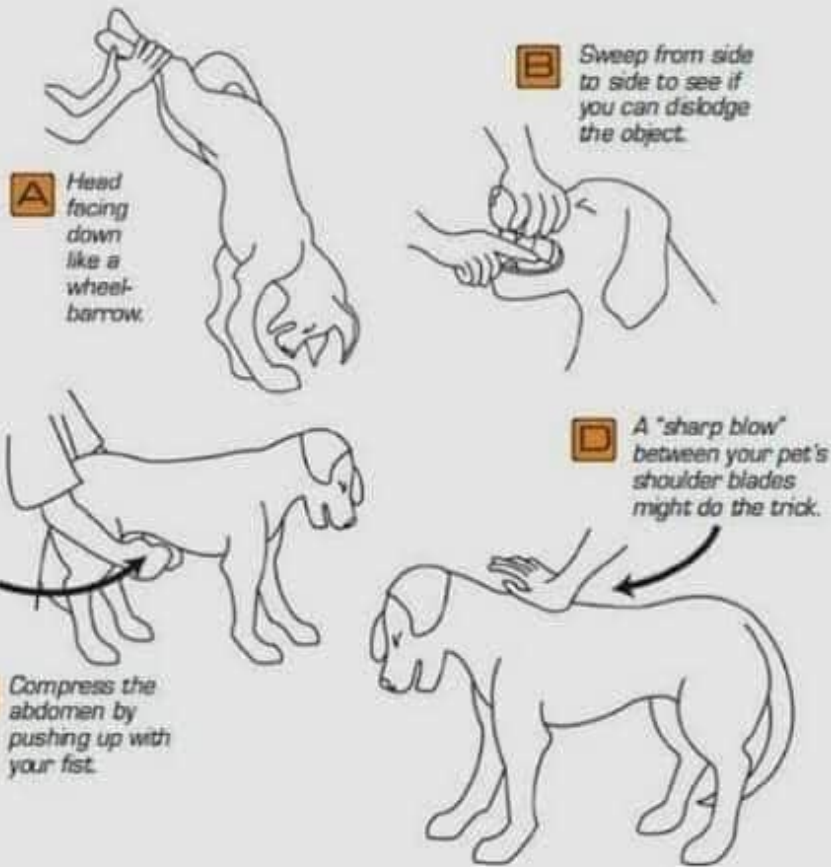
