Dear members:

The change in the membership discount rules seems to have confused some members. So let me try again. Please read this completely.

1. Because the new rules started in March – **JUST FOR 2024** – you will have until July 31st to complete the requirements that must be done in the first part of the year. Those requirements are: – 1. you must assist in cleaning the building at least once and 2. assist with another club sponsored activity at least once. Eligible club sponsored activities include: stewarding, helping with classes, helping with eye clinics, temperament testing, CGC testing, representing the club at a civic event...and more. If you have a question about this, ask me.
2. **IMPORTANT** When you **clean** or **assist**, you **MUST sign The book** on the table that is marked Cleaning and Assisting and include the date and what you helped with. This is the only way we will know what you did.
3. IF you have already cleaned, stewarded, or whatever at any time in 2024 and did not sign the book, go back to the book and record the date and what you did.
4. BE sure your writing is legible. If it isn't, your information will not be recorded.

If you still need to clean or assist with a club event, you still have plenty of time. There will be 2 cleanings in June and 2 cleaning in July. Plus, our July Obedience/Rally trial will have lots of opportunities to steward.

I appreciate the many members who are generous with their time and keep our classes and activities going.

OBEDIENCE CLUB OF DAYTONA**GENERAL MEETING****May 13, 2024**

President Pat Mozden started the meeting at 7:00pm. The sign in sheet had been passed around. Eighteen members were present. Minutes of the last meeting were not read because they were published in the Chatterbarks newsletter.

Pat's update started with the website which is still a work in progress. Every time we get close to going live Chris seems to find another thing that needs to be tweaked.

Ralph had an alternate suggestion for the front windows. Light weight foam boards that have a silver reflective side attached to the white foam structure are available with R-Ratings of 5 or 10. The reflective side would block the heat. These would be installed where the sheets are now. Ralph said they are easy to install. He will check on the prices and let us know.

Pat wants to make sure our members are aware that we have a "first responder program". To qualify for the program they would have to be currently working or retired from the following professions: first responder, military, law enforcement, fire, or emergency medical services. If they came and took a Basic or a Puppy class from OCOD, as long as they complete 6 out of 7 classes, we will reimburse them for the full amount of the class. This is a really good way to thank first responders and the military for everything that they do.

Pat said there are updated requirements to get the discount on classes. You need to clean once every six months and assist with another club activity whether you help with classes, trials, or another club activity like teeth cleaning or the eye clinic. All members to qualify for the club discount will be required to do that. We are going to be strict about this as well. If you don't meet the requirements we will require that people pay the full price. (Everyone needs to sign into the cleaning book when you follow the requirements and write in which job you did).

Pat asked if anyone was interested in taking over the job of Raffle Baskets to please contact her.

Committee trial chairs need to find someone they could train to do their jobs in the event they needed backup in an emergency or a problem of any kind.

Problems with the A/C should be resolved next week. Jim found problems that had not been discovered by previous A/C repair people. We are so lucky to have Jim diagnosing problems and making sure they are fixed correctly. Big Thanks to Jim from all of us. You are appreciated.

Pat received information from AKC regarding bringing dogs in from other countries. They are not going to allow dogs under the age of six months to come into the country. Pat said she would put a blurb in the newsletter with more details. Pat asked for Wins and Brags and she congratulated everyone. Any new wins and brags should be submitted to Joan for the Chatterbarks.

Ralph said our upcoming trial is doing well. We have good judges coming and good help signed up. Jacksonville trial filled up and they couldn't fit everyone in. Rally for Jacksonville ran late till 6pm because there were so many that signed up. Ralph asked Allison why she didn't have Rally on Friday. She said she didn't know how much the extra day would cost and she was concerned because Friday was a workday. Ralph said we had plenty of entries on Friday for the OCOD trial. Ralph said he staggered the judges starting times for us and it worked great.

There was a suggestion on how we could make more money for the club if we offered Temperament Testing. It's very easy to set up with minimal equipment. There are two judges so you could have your dog run twice and have a title. You could charge \$30 for each run. It can be held in conjunction with a show, an AKC event, or a stand alone event. You can do it with any dog as long as the dog has a number with AKC. It can be held indoors. Pat asked Sharon to come back next month and tell us more about Temperament Testing. Pat called for the meeting to be adjourned.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:46pm.

Always ask a veterinarian before giving any medication to your dog. Even "safe" human meds can be toxic to certain breeds or pets with preexisting conditions.

BENDADRYL
FOR ALLERGIES AND ITCHING
1 milligram per pound of dog

DRAMAMINE FOR MOTION SICKNESS
12.5 milligrams for small dogs
25 milligrams for medium dogs
50 milligrams for large dogs

HYDROGEN PEROXIDE
USED TO INDUCE VOMITING AFTER ACCIDENTAL INGESTION OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES
10 milliliters by mouth

HYDROCORTISONE
FOR ITCHING OR IRRITATED SKIN
Small amount applied topically up to twice daily

PEPCID AC (FAMOTIDINE) / ZANTAC (RANITIDINE)
TO REDUCE STOMACH ACIDS CAUSED BY ULCERS, ACID REFLUX OR BELLYACHE
1/4 tablet for dogs under 20 pounds
1/2 tablet for dogs 20-60 pounds
1 tablet for dogs over 60 pounds

BUFFERED ASPIRIN
TO RELIEVE PAIN AND INFLAMMATION
1/2 baby aspirin for dogs under 10 pounds
1 baby aspirin for dogs 10-30 pounds
1/2 regular aspirin for dogs 30-50 pounds
1 regular aspirin for dogs 50-100 pounds

1/4 adult dose for small dogs
1/2 adult dose for medium dogs
1 adult dose for large dogs

IMODIUM A-D
FOR DIARRHEA
1 milligram per pound of dog

ROBITUSSIN DM
FOR COUGHING OR HACKING
1 teaspoon per 10 pounds of dog's weight
