President's Message,

Dear Members:

It's time to review the club policy about **remaining eligible for club discounts** when taking classes. Keeping the doors open, classes and activities going, and having a clean training center to work in takes participation from everyone who enjoys the indoor training center and/or Silver Sands for agility. To that end, the club has the following policy:

Members must participate in a minimum of one group cleaning **AND** assist with one trial, class, or other club activity every six months. We are in the first 6 months of the year so many members still need to fulfill their obligations- a minimum of one cleaning and one other club activity between January 1st and June 30th.

I hope you appreciate the large, well-kept facility we train in and will do more than the minimum and, in fact, we have many members who do so. If you have the time to train, you have the time to help keep our facilities in good order. If your activities are limited to agility, you have obligations that are specific to that equipment and location.

In between cleanings, other needs can arise such as; supplies needed in a bathroom or next to tables (the bucket that contains cleaning fluid and paper towels). Please take the initiative to take care of those needs. Do not assume “someone else will do it.” That someone is you. If you do not know where those supplies are kept ask a board member or other experienced member. Every bit of help is needed and appreciated.

Keep your eyes open for notices about dates and times for the monthly cleanings.





