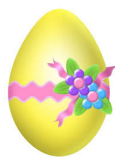

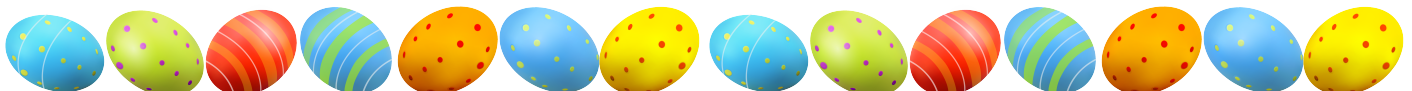
I would like to thank the members who came out and worked the last cleaning.

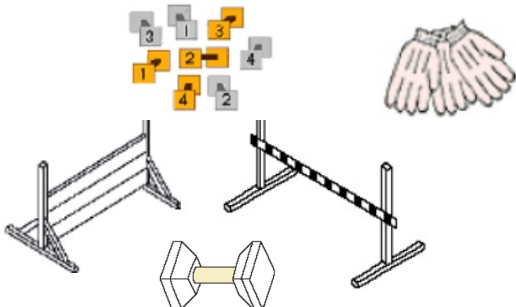
