President's Message

Everyone living in Florida knows we are entering peak hurricane season, and we know hurricanes are more frequent and dangerous than in recent decades. So, we need to prepare ourselves, our homes, and our evacuation plans to remain safe. Those of us with pets need to make additional preparations to keep our furry family members safe as well.

First, do you have an evacuation plan? Riding out hurricanes used to be the norm. We hardly ever gave a thought to leaving in the past. Not now. We all need to have a plan in place regarding where we will go if a strong storm is headed in our direction.

Of course we will take our dogs. They should never be left at home if you leave.

Will you go to a relative? A hotel? A shelter? Leave the area/state? You should have an escape plan that includes phone numbers and evacuation routes.

Most club members crate their dogs but if you don't, now is the time to crate train them. If you end up at a shelter, they will be required to be crated. Many hotels that normally do not allow dogs will accept pets that are being evacuated if they are crate trained.

Take nonperishable dog food with you. You will almost certainly be able to find people food but may not find dog food so don't be caught. Finally, be prepared to be without power for at least several days. And if your neighborhood floods – you have your own set of needs. We hope none of this will be necessary but it's definitely a case of better safe than sorry.

Good luck to all of us this season.

AIR TEMPERATURE	CONCRETE	ASPHALT
75°	90°	125°
80°	95°	130°
85°	105°	135°
90°	125°	140°
95°	140°	150°

Asphalt can be 40-60 degrees hotter than the air temperature. Test the pavement. Hold the back of your hand down for 10 seconds, if it burns your hand, it can burn your dog's paws.

Added: H. Class and Seminar credits may be used by members only. Once membership is given up credits cannot be used.

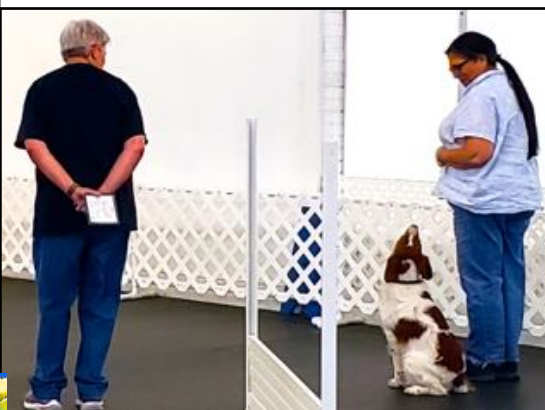
