Each Obedience and Rally Trial is a separate AKC event, even when multiple trials occur on the same day. Exhibitors must pay the FIRST ENTRY fee for each dog in each trial entered. For example, a dog is entered in Trial 1 Novice B (\$31.00) and Trial 2 Novice B (\$31.00) would pay a total of \$62.00.

**RIBBONS and AWARDS:**

The following are offered by the Obedience Club of Daytona. A qualifying score is required for all regular-class awards. Items must be picked up in person or by a designated representative on the day of the Trial. No items will be mailed. Unclaimed items become the property of OCOD. OCOD reserves the right to substitute an item of equal value.

**New Title Rosettes will be offered**

**ROSETTES OBEDIENCE and RALLY CLASSES** (except non-regular)

Placement rosettes are offered in each regular Obedience class, Alternate Titling class, and Rally class for 1st through 4th place.

A placement toy is offered in Obedience Novice A & B, Beginner Novice A & B, and Rally Novice A & B, with recognition given for 1st through 4th place in each class.

Qualifying ribbons are given to all exhibitors with scores of 170 or higher in Obedience and 70 or higher in Rally

**OBEDIENCE and RALLY CLASS AWARDS:**

AWARDS will be presented after the completion of the classes involved and must be picked up on the same day of the trial.

**Note: Dog means either sex. Entries in non-regular classes are only eligible for non-regular class awards.**

**NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS:**

**CLOSING DATE for entries is Wednesday, June 24, 2026, after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed per move up clause below. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees.**

**No telephone or fax entries can be accepted. EXPRESS DELIVERY services must include SIGNATURE WAIVER permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient's signature.**

Regular Class entries, including the UDX class, will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling Classes followed by the Non-Regular Classes.

**Returned Check: There will be a \$60.00 fee for any returned check**

**AKC Recording Fees: Entry fees include a \$4.50 Obedience/Rally Event fee for each entry at every club licensed. Non-Regular Classes are excluded. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and remitted to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC Rule effective January 1, 2026)**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, unsafe weather conditions or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Transfers:

- After a dog earns a title, a transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

For a written request regarding a transfer for an ineligible dog and handler team from the "A" class to the "B" class at the same level, please refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16b

**VACCINATIONS ETC.** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**BITCHES** that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee less \$5.00 per dog per class refunded upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

**ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS:**

\* Misconduct at hotels/motels may result in an Event Committee hearing. \* Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs at the OCOD Training Building and at hotels/motels. Your continued responsibility and respect allow hotels / motels to continue to work with OCOD so we can provide you with the best venue possible. Please relieve your dogs in marked areas outside and be careful not to allow your dog to mark or urinate inside or on the buildings, trash cans and cars nearby. Trash cans are placed throughout the grounds-please use them. \* The OCOD Training building is a smoke-free building. \* Per AKC rules no dogs are allowed in the show

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

## AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
