

After Smokey passed on December 21, 2023, the very next day he had visits scheduled at the Emory L Bennett Veteran's Home and also at the old VA Clinic.

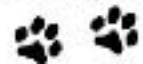
Trumpet was not certified yet but with her great composure and manners and also as a super high level obedience dog, I was certain that she would not have an issue making these visits.

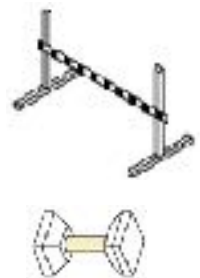
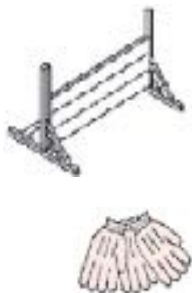
